

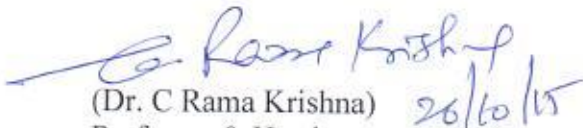

Guidelines for Pre-thesis / Final Thesis Report writing

Follow these guidelines strictly while writing report for pre/final thesis:

1. Font Size:
 - Chapter heading Size 16 (Bold) uppercase
 - Sub heading e.g 1.1 14 (Bold) uppercase
 - Subtitles e.g. 1.1.1 12 (Bold) uppercase
 - Subtitles e.g. 1.1.1.1 12 (Bold) titlecase
 - Text (script) 12
2. Font: Times New Roman Line spacing : 1½
3. There should be uniformity in writing headings and sub-headings in all chapters
4. Avoid underlines and colon i.e. :
5. To indicate a figure, write below the figure and the format should be **Fig.1.5.**
6. To indicate a table, write above the table and the format should be **Table 1.5.**
7. All the figure captions and table captions should be **12 size, bold and title case**
8. All the figures and tables should be mentioned/referred/explained in the adjoining paragraphs
9. Always number the equations, tables and figures chapter wise, for e.g. 4th figure in chapter 5 will bear the number Fig.5.4.
10. Never write report in first person i.e. "I will do this". Instead write author....
11. In Literature survey, do not give full mention of the paper. Instead write like this:
Gambhir et al. in [1] have discussed/concluded/suggested/reported. Here [1] is the number of the paper mentioned in References and Bibliography
12. In References and Bibliography, the mention of paper should be
[1] Chatterji S. (the names of all authors), "Title", Journal or proceedings of the conference, Vol.5, Issue/No.2, pp 365-370, month, year of publication.

Journal Article

[1] S.K. Kenue and J.F. Greenleaf, "Limited angle multifrequency diffraction tomography," IEEE Trans. Sonics Ultrason., vol. SU-29, no. 6, pp. 213-217, July 1982.

Conference Article

[2] R. Finkel, R. Taylor, R. Bolles, R. Paul, and J. Feldman, "An overview of AL programming system for automation," in *Proc. Fourth Int. Joint Conf Artif. Intell.*, pp. , 758-765, Sept. 3-7, 1975.

13. The references should be placed in the chapters in the form as [1] , in the order of occurrence.
14. There should be uniformity in writing headings of chapters for e.g.,

CHAPTER ONE

TITLE

- If this is placed at the centre of page, then it should be at the centre in all the chapters.
- Also do not underline it.

15. The sequence of chapters should be like this

- Chapter 1 Introduction
- Chapter 2 Literature Survey
 - 2.1 Literature Review
 - 2.2 Inferences Drawn from Literature Review
- Chapter 3 Problem Formulation and Proposed Work
 - 3.1 Problem Definition
 - 3.2 Objectives
 - 3.3 Proposed Work
- Chapter 4 Methodology
 - 4.1 Implementation Strategy (Flowchart, Algorithm etc.)
 - 4.2 Tools/Hardware/Software to be used
 - 4.3 Expected Outcome (Performance metrics with details)
- References and Bibliography (It should **not** be a chapter and should be included at the end)

16. There should be a concluding paragraph at the end of each chapter, this paragraph should be the conclusion of that chapter and an introduction to the next chapter.

17. Check the spellings

18. A sample of content writing in table of contents is given below. This should be strictly followed in every chapter.

19. The sequence in the file should be like this:

Title page
 Student's Declaration
 Certificate from Supervisor
 Abstract
 Acknowledgement
 Table of Contents

List of Figures
List of Tables
List of Abbreviations
Chapters
Conclusion and Future Work
References
List of Publication out of this Thesis
Appendix (*If any*)

20. Report should be printed double sided.
21. Starting pages should be Roman numbered without number on title page.
22. Thesis should be hard bounded with black color and golden print (engrossed).
