## TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE TRANSFER OF EXPENDITURE FROM GRANT-IN-AID HEADS TO IRG OF THE INSTITUTION

The esteemed members discussed the issue in depth. The following emerged out of the deliberations:

- (i) The IRG of the institute which is kept as corpus fund in the institute is also government fund. Hence to be used for those overhead expenditure where there is a shortfall of grant released by MHRD, GOI
- (ii) The OH-36 and OH-31 are to be estimated and projected in the Budget Estimates so that adequate grant is released under these Heads to meet the requirement of the institute. This will avoid negative balance and use of corpus fund to meet the requirement of the institute. Ministry may be requested to release adequate grant as per requirement.
- (iii) The proposal of the institute to the Finance Committee on decreasing IRG by Rs 405.51 and increasing the opening balance of GIA by an equal amount during 2008-19 was accepted and recommended to the BOGs for approval.

Committee Finance and Board of Governors in its meeting held on 03.12.2018 has approved the transfer of expenditure for ₹405.51 lacs from IRG to the opening balance of grant for the year 2018-19. The competent authority of this institute has approved the transfer of grant from the available balance of IRG to Grant-in-Aid heads to adjust the negative balance of previous years.

## ITEM NO.F.41.4.4 CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOUSES AT SECTOR 42 CHANDIGARH

The institute vide Item No. F.39.2/F.33.3.7 approved the new construction in the year 2018-19 and 2019-2020. The same was approved by BOGs and approval was also received from the Ministry with a rider that the overall limit of 75 mt.sq per student to be maintained. The institute communicated to the Architect of Chandigarh Administration. The reply has been received which was discussed in the institute Campus Planning and Development Committee. The Committee has recommended construction of 8 Nos. of Type-VI, 8 Nos. of Type-V and 8 Nos. of IV-A houses. Hon'ble Members may kindly approve the same.
