### Annexure -I

In order to negate the adverse effect of Covid Pandemic on the continuing education of students enrolled under different Post Graduate programmes of the Institute, all the classes were run through ICT mode lest the studies of all get hampered. Following measures were implemented in the Institute for the welfare of all concerned.

- All the students residing in the hostels were placed in single occupancy room to maintain social distancing.
- Staggered timings were implemented in the hostel mess.
- All the students and staff were advised to strictly follow the Covid protocols, as released by local administration from time to time through circulars and notices. The Institute issued the Covid Protocols & guidelines for time to time.
- No physical classes were run during Covid Pandemic.
- Mass testing of all in the Institute were arranged on two occasions to isolate cases, if any.
- Institute installed hand sanitizers at all entry points <sup>and adjacent to washrooms</sup> besides sanitizing all the buildings at regular intervals apart from regulating the entry of all outside guests. Wearing of masks was made compulsory for all the faculty, staff, students and visitors.
- Most of the meetings were conducted online.

- All the students residing in the hostels were placed in single occupancy room to maintain social distancing.
- Staggered timings were implemented in the hostel mess.
- All the students and staff were advised to strictly follow the Covid protocols, as released by local administration from time to time through circulars and notices. The Institute issued the Covid Protocols & guidelines for time to time.
- No physical classes were run during Covid Pandemic.
- Mass testing of all in the Institute were arranged on two occasions to isolate cases, if any.
- Institute installed hand sanitizers at all entry points and adjacent to wash rooms besides sanitizing all the buildings at regular intervals apart from regulating the entry of all outside guests. Wearing of masks was made compulsory for all the faculty, staff, students and visitors.
- Most of the meetings were conducted online.
